

MEMBERSHIP - Associate / Student Member

'Associate or Student Membership' is open to any individual engaged in cultural heritage activities or studies, who does not meet the requirements for full Individual Membership.

Applicants who do not meet the requirements for Full Membership can be admitted as Associate Members until such time as they are able to qualify for Full Membership. This category is also suitable for prospective members who are studying full- or part-time.

This category may also be utilised by those who do not have cultural heritage work as a core professional activity or no longer actively involved in heritage practice on a professional basis.

Membership of ICOMOS Ireland does not confer any professional accreditation and should not be used in this context.

After three years, with full-time conservation experience, qualifying Associate Members will be sent a reminder to upgrade to Full Membership prior to membership renewal at the end of the financial year. The notification will explain the requirements for Full Membership and the application process for upgrading their membership.

Application requirements

- A completed application form (nominators are not required for Associate Members)
- Curriculum Vitae
- A personal statement (max. 500 words) of relevant professional experience.
- Confirmation the applicant has read, understood and commits to the Ethical Principles for ICOMOS Members.



Additional requirements

For **STUDENT applicants** – evidence of full time enrolment in a recognised heritage or conservation course at the time of application and renewal is required.
